“The teachers are really nice and want to help you.”

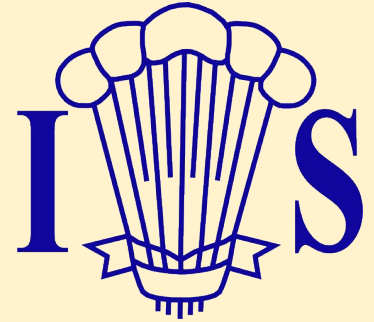
“Making friends is easy at Imberhorne”

“I love coming to Imberhorne, it’s great.”

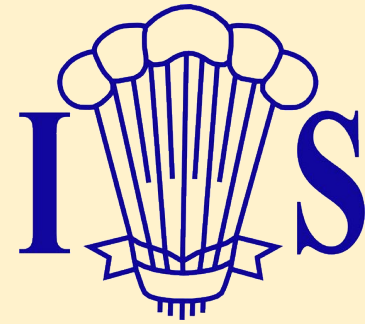
Communication

- Parents can contact school by phone, written note, and email. This is important if you are sick, have appointments and are not in school, or have information from home to share with school.

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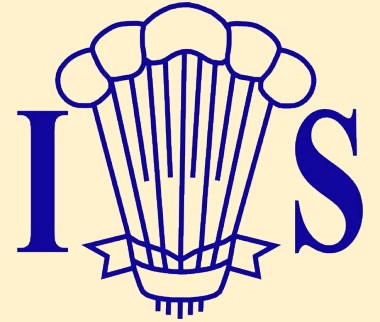

- There are a variety of additional clubs after school – lists are published and students can ask their teachers. They are a great way to meet new people!

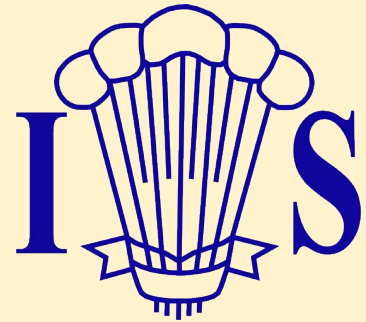
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Bromcom: MyChildatSchool

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Uniform



We want our students to feel proud to wear the uniform:

- Shoes need to be plain black and polishable (leather or leather looking)
- Non uniform hoodies and jumpers are not permitted
- Socks are not needed with tights

PLEASE SEE UNIFORM CHECKLIST

Trousers

Plain black and regular. Trousers should not be tight from hip to ankle, nor should they be of a pair or thin style/material.



Polo Shirt

Imberhorne shirt to be worn at all times with no other clothes visible underneath.



Black tailored shorts



Jumper

Imberhorne jumper to be worn on top of the polo shirt. It can be taken off but not worn around the waist or shoulders.



Hoodie

Imberhorne hoodie to be worn on top of the polo shirt and jumper. It is not to be worn without an Imberhorne jumper underneath.

Hair

Must be a uniform style, not shaved or cut very short. Lines cut into the hair are expressly forbidden. Dyed hair must be discreet and natural in appearance.

Jewellery

One small stud in each ear lobe. No additional piercings or jewellery allowed.

Make-Up & Nail Varnish

Students should not wear nail varnish / acrylics etc at either lay stage. ICB students may wear a discreet amount of make up.

Skirts (Optional)

Imberhorne school skirt which carries the school logo above the hem to be worn at knee length.



Shoes & Socks

Plain black polished shoes. Must have black soles and no visible white lugs. No boots, plimsolls, or backless shoes. Plain black socks or tights.

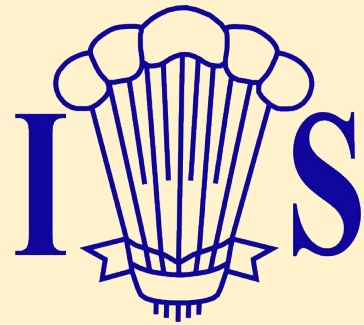


Unisex Plain White Polo Shirt

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Jewellery



- One small stud in each ear lobe and a watch
- We deliberately keep this rule very simple and straightforward.
- Nothing gets lost, stolen, broken. No Health and safety issues – SIMPLE

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KS3 Equipment List Essential

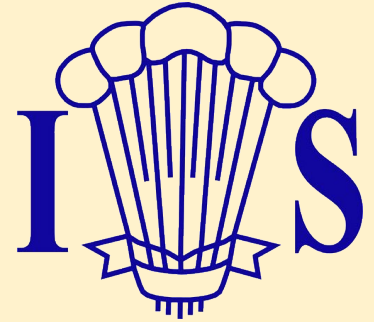
- 2 black biros

Combo Pencil Sharpener Eraser.



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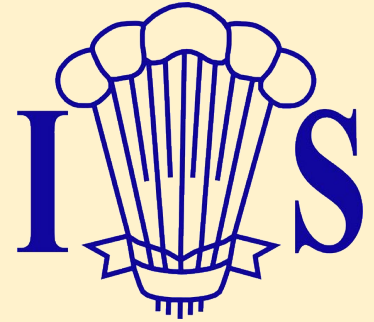
Mobile Phones



- Mobile phones and any other connected devices and gadgets eg airpods, are NOT allowed to be used in school.
- They can be brought to school, turned off before you enter school and placed in bags.
- **Phones seen or heard will be confiscated.**

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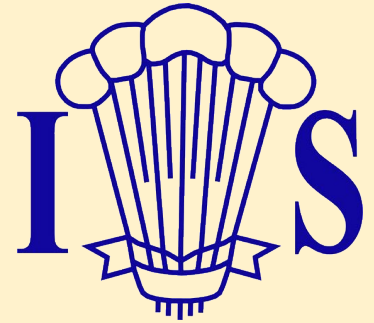
Rewards



- You can collect Achievement points to earn a range of Awards.
- Students will receive certificates and special prizes for each award achieved.
- Reward points can be earned for anything from effort and progress to service to the school, taking part in clubs or teams etc.

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Behaviour



- We hope that everything will be very positive for your children, however occasionally there may be some negative behaviours.
- We have a system that offers students opportunity to correct behaviour. However, if these opportunities aren't taken this may result in after school detentions if it becomes serious. You will always be informed if there is an after school detention.

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Homework



- Teachers provide homework to support students learning. This will often follow class topics or future projects
- We have homework set through Bromcom. Students are also encouraged to make a note in their planner.
- Get ready for homework with a space and time in the day to do this. It will prepare you for future exams and studies

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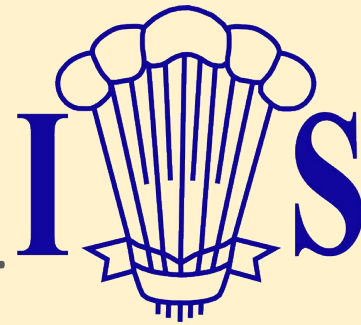
School Buses

- West Sussex are responsible for bus allocation. Support in school, if required, will be given by Mrs Cook.

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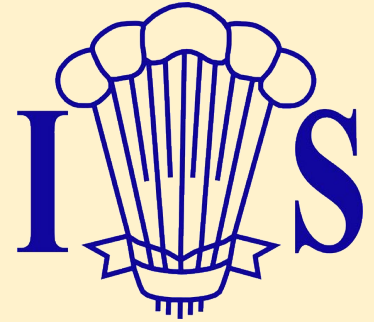
Other Info
